Worship is at the heart of what we do and who we are. We gather at regular times throughout the week to sing, pray, reflect, and share communion. Student-oriented services range from contemplative evening prayer on Sundays at 7:30 p.m. (preceded by dinner at 6:45) to our more festive Wednesday intergenerational service at 5:30 p.m. (followed by an all-parish community dinner).

Grow in the knowledge and love of God and deepen your faith, all within an open and inquiring environment. We host weekly small group gatherings, like Conversations on Faith & Life, to explore the "big questions" of life, faith, and belief and the connections between academic learning and how we live our lives in the world. We have regular book discussions, bible studies, and special events with guest speakers.

Connect with friends, deepen relationships, and have fun together. We organize regular fellowship events and activities, such as hiking trips, spring cookouts, movie/game nights, and weekend retreats. Students also regularly gather informally in our cozy study room at St. Paul's (always stocked with free snacks and beverages).

Serve our neighbors and promote the common good. Students have led volunteer service projects to clean up our waterways and rivers, cook meals at the local shelter, assist in a nearby community garden, contribute to Habitat for Humanity, and more.

MUSIC at ST PAULS on the CORNER

Music, rooted in the Anglican tradition, is vital to our worship at St. Paul's, and important to our outreach beyond our walls. There are many opportunities to experience and participate through vibrant congregational singing, excellent choirs for children and adults, and beautiful instrumental offerings.



- Parish Choir: The Parish Choir is the principal musical ensemble of St. Paul's, singing each week for the 10 a.m. Sunday service, as well as for major feast days, choral evensong, and special concerts. For many years, our Parish Choir has involved students (both undergraduate and graduate students).
- Choral Scholars: The choral scholar program at St. Paul's is a paid internship program intended to introduce talented young musicians to quality choral music in a church setting.

Featured Instrumentalists:

Talented instrumentalists are often featured in our 10 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. worship services. In recent years, we've had students play cello, flute, violin and sing, sharing their gifts in worship.

Special services, concerts:

Singers who are not able to commit to the Parish Choir schedule are often invited to sing for special worship services, either in ensemble or as soloists.







Episcopal Church Leadership Scholarship

Since 2015, St. Paul's has awarded \$1,768,000 in ECL Scholarships to Episcopal students at UVA.

The University has entrusted St. Paul's, as the official Episcopal chaplaincy at UVA, with the honor of selecting the recipients of a unique scholarship for Episcopal students. We anticipate awarding more than \$250,000 in scholarships for the 2024-2025 academic year.
